

# LEADERSHIP ROAD MAP - EAMBA 31

Center for Leadership Development (CLD)

Requirements for 1st YR Students: Follow the instructions in each box.

In addition to the required Leadership course (DBC 506), to complete the Leadership Road Map fall enrollees must complete a combination of four (4) Leadership Development Experiences (LDEs) and Leadership Programs/Events (1 of the 4 must be a LDE) and a minimum of four (4) hours of community service. (All programs are not offered each term.)

## Leadership Development Experiences (LDEs)\*

Must choose at least ONE to complete Leadership Road Map

- Leadership in Action program and/or Leadership Simulation
- Leadership Coaching (eligible in spring term)\*
- Serve on Leadership Student Advisory Board (LSAB)\*
- Toastmasters (attend a minimum of 3 meetings, serve in a functionary role, and give icebreaker speech)
- Participate in MBA Nonprofit Board Member program\*
- Political Leadership Institute (must attend 2-day session)\*
- Participation in other Crummer/Rollins/ Off-Campus designated and approved Leadership Experiences (e.g., Toastmasters' Officer Training, Officer in Student Organization, Crummer Exchange Student Mentor Program, Leadership Conferences, Leadership Simulations, or other CLD designated and approved events, experiences and/or leadership roles)\*

*\*Opportunities may require application, be limited, competitive, and/or requires documentation from organization or may not be eligible until spring term.*

## Leadership Programs/Events\*

May choose as many as you like; however, cannot complete Road Map by only choosing from this section):

- Leadership Lunch & Learn
- Bagels with the Board (BWB)
- Leadership Book Club (minimum # of students required)
- Other designated Leadership events or experiences (on/off campus (must be designated and approved by CLD)

*\*After participating in one Leadership Development Experience (LDE), additional LDEs may be used to substitute for a program/event.*

## Community Service

Minimum 4 hours of documented participation in one of the options below or participation in a combination of both

- CLD sponsored or cosponsored community service Project
- Your own community service project on/off campus

## Academic Experiences

- Academic; Required Leadership class; Leadership with an Entrepreneurial Mindset (DBC 506)

## Certificate in Leadership

### Integrated Capstone Experience (ICE) - Leadership Track

The Certificate in Leadership is **ONLY** available to students who enrolled in the Leadership Track.

*Note: Completion of ICE Leadership Track meets 2nd YR Road Map requirements.*

## Leadership Development Experiences (LDEs)

### Choose a Minimum of Two:

- Continue serving on MBA Nonprofit Board (limited to current board members)
- Leadership Coaching
- Leadership in Action Experience; Leadership Simulation
- Leader Shadow program (open to students who completed 1<sup>st</sup> year Road Map)
- Leadership Book Club (lead discussion) (minimum # of students required)
- Attend programs/events designated by CLD as credit for 2nd year students (e.g., Leadership Lunch & Learn, BWB, and/or other CLD, Classroom, Student Organization Speaker events or participate in other designated/approved experiences)
- Toastmasters (present a minimum of 4 speeches or serve as officer)
- Serve on CLD Student Advisory Board (maximum 6 2<sup>nd</sup> year students)
- Political Leadership Institute (if available must attend 2-day session)
- Leadership Winter Park Scholarship (application required for selection by June of each year)
- Other Leadership role/experience on-campus not sponsored by CLD: Officer in student organization, EAMBA Ambassador; Exchange Student Mentor; EM LYON (France); Entrepreneurial Leadership Connection, etc.
- Other Leadership Experience off-campus: leadership position in a work environment or community service project (must be pre-approved by CLD)

*Requires documentation of participation unless sponsored by CLD; opportunities may also be limited, competitive, and/or require application or selection process. External options may also require pre-approval.*

## SunTrust Distinguished Leader of Merit

Only students who completed the 1st YR Road Map, are pursuing 2nd YR Leadership Road Map and highly engaged in the CLD are eligible to compete.
