

**PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

**Executive Doctorate in Business Administration Class 13 – Fall 2025**

The total cost of tuition for the **Executive Doctorate in Business Administration Class 13** is **\$103,700**. FoxPay is the official online student account and payment system for Rollins College. Monthly billing statements are uploaded to the student’s FoxPay account located at <https://rollins.college/studentpay> and on [MyRollins](https://www.rollins.edu/myrollins).

Tuition balance must be paid by 5 pm on the published due date or student will not be permitted to attend classes. Accounts with a past due balance of \$200 or greater will be subject to holds and a monthly late fee equal to 1% of the past due amount as outlined in the holds & late fee policy posted at <http://www.rollins.edu/sas>. Student who wish to explore financial aid options should contact the Financial Aid Office directly through their site at <https://www.rollins.edu/financial-aid/index.html>.

Tuition does not cover the cost of books, supplies, EDBA association fee, or parking decal.

At the beginning of Term 1, students will automatically be billed the following non-refundable one-time fees:

- \$200 Association Fee
- \$225 Parking Decal

**Refund Policy for Fall 2025 Term Only** - The tuition deposit, association fee, and parking decal are non-refundable.

**Fall A Term Courses**

- Withdrawal before 8 am on August 14, 2025. . . . . 100%
- Withdrawal after 8 am on August 14, 2025 . . . . . 75%
- Withdrawal before 8 am on September 19, 2025 . . . . . 50%
- No refunds after 8 am on September 19, 2025

**Fall B Term Courses**

- Withdrawal before 8 am on November 1, 2025. . . . . 100%
- Withdrawal before 8 am on November 15, 2025 . . . . . 50%
- No refunds after 8 am on November 15, 2025

**Refund Policy for Summer Terms Only**

- Withdrawal before 8 am on term start date. . . . . 100%
- Withdrawal before 8 am on 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of term . . . . . 50%
- No refunds after 8 am on 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of term

**Refund Policy for Remaining Fall and Spring terms (applicable for Full-term, Part A, & Part B)**

- Withdrawal before 8 am on term start date . . . . . 100%
- Withdrawal before 8 am on 1<sup>st</sup> Friday of weekend session. 50%
- No refunds after 8 am on 1<sup>st</sup> Friday of weekend session

**DIS 704 – Dissertation 4 is scheduled to be completed by the end of the program on August 31, 2028.** Any student that has not met this requirement will be continually registered for the course named **DIS 704 -Dissertation Continuation** for a total of 6 credit hours at the tuition rate of \$10,200 for every semester until completion for continuous advisement.

**Time Limitation** - EDBA students have five consecutive calendar years from the semester of the first credited registration, including leaves of absence, to complete all requirements for the degree. Any EDBA student who fails to complete the requirements within the five-year limit will be subject to separation from further study unless granted an extension by the EDBA Academic Committee subject to the recommendation of the student’s faculty advisor or dissertation committee. An extension may be granted if the student and their advisor work out a plan of action for completion within an additional two-year time frame. The request must be made in writing by the student and supported by the advisor, then submitted to the EDBA Academic Director for consideration by the EDBA Academic Committee. Students who fail to complete degree requirements after 7 years will be automatically removed from the EDBA program.
